



until 1974. Last year saw the pilgrimage revived after an absence 41 years.

"Last year's event was a tremendous success with numbers attending far in excess to expectations and everybody having an enormously enjoyable day – this year should prove to be even better," added the Archbishop.

The revived summer pilgrimage is the initiative of the local Catholic parish in Dunfermline, St Margaret's Memorial Church. In 2015, they invited parishes within the

Archdiocese of St Andrews & Edinburgh to attend. Following the success of last year's event, this year they are extending the invitation to all the Catholic parishes in Scotland – 452 parishes in total - in co-operation with the Bishops' Conference of Scotland.

"This will be a real family event to which everybody in Scotland not just Catholics - are invited given that St Margaret is an inspirational figure for all Scots as well as a heavenly protectress of the people of our land,"

said Fr Chris Heenan, Parish Priest of St Margaret's Memorial Church.

St Margaret became Queen of Scots in 1070. She was renowned for her good influence on her husband, King Malcolm III, but also for her devout Christian piety, her charitable works towards the sick and poor while raising eight children of her own. She is credited with encouraging the observance of Sunday as a day of rest. Saint Margaret was declared Patroness of Scotland in 1673.
