After the Summer break we hope to re-start the Children's Liturgy at the 9am Mass in August for young children (P1-P3) who have not yet received the Sacraments.



Gillian MacKay MSP has launched a public consultation to bring in buffer zones around facilities that provide abortion in Scotland.

- Q11 in the consultation highlights the direction of travel of this move.
- The "precautionary" approach put forward in the bill is one of its most disturbing aspects. *It is designed to punish people attending pro-life vigils before any offence has been committed.* * The police will have the power to arrest and charge pro-life people without any crime being reported and without the need to provide any evidence of a crime. * The precautionary approach is an unprecedented departure from the rule of law and should be categorically rejected. *This approach seeks to punish people who have committed no crime and would allow the police to arrest and charge people without evidence of a crime. Such a proposal has no place in a free society. First offence 6 months in prison: subsequent offences up to 2 years for saying a prayer!
