St. Teresa of Avila (1515–1582), born Teresa Sánchez Cepeda Dávila y Ahumada in Ávila, Spain, was a Carmelite reformer, mystic, and one of the great figures of the Catholic Counter-Reformation. From a devout family of Jewish converts, she developed deep spiritual zeal as a child. After her mother's death, she embraced devotion to the Virgin Mary and later joined the Carmelite Order against her

father's wishes. Despite severe illness, Teresa pursued a life of prayer and contemplation, experiencing profound mystical visions that inspired her writings and reforms. With St. John of the Cross, she founded the Discalced Carmelites, restoring the order's simplicity and austerity. Canonized in 1622, she was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1970 for her lasting spiritual influence.
